

Spring Semester Final

TASK:

You are to create a Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) Project. SAE projects can include anything agriculturally related. It can be an ownership project like a plant or animal project or a placement project which is when you work for someone like a vineyard manager or vet.

REQUIREMENTS:

- **PRESENTATION:** You will create a presentation of your SAE for finals week. (see guidelines below)
- **TIME INVESTED:** It is expected that you dedicate at least 32 hours to the project spread out over the months of February, March, April and May (it works out to 8 hours per month)
- **RECORD BOOK:** A completed official FFA record book logging skills, hours, expenses, income, etc. We will work in class to set these up but some time outside of class time may be necessary.
- **PORTFOLIO:** This will include a resume, 6 pictures, copies of some record book pages, typed written summary of the project identifying at least 8 skills learned from the project.

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES:

There are two options for your presentation-

Create a Blog:

- Using blogger (works with gmail) create a blog space to document your project and what you have done.
- Must have 3 blog entries for each month (February to May)
- Must contain a picture with every blog entry (minimum of 12)
- Identify and discuss at least 8 skills learned throughout the project

Create a Video:

- Create an 8 minute video with transitions, pictures and live video documenting your projects.
- Must include video from the beginning of the project to the end (example- when you bought your pig to when you sold it at the fair)
- Must have at least 12 pictures in addition to video footage
- Identify and discuss at least 8 skills learned throughout the project

At least 50% of the videos/pictures must have YOU in them!!!!
